MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This **Memorandum of Understanding** (hereinafter called as the 'MoU') is entered into on this 05 April 2025.

BETWEEN

Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj College Of Engineering Shegaon - 444203, Dist. Buldhana, the First Party represented herein by its **Principal Dr. S. B. Somani** (hereinafter referred as 'First Party', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

AND

SW Systems, Pune, and represented herein by its Director, **Mrs. Reshma Golsangi** (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution aimed
 - (I) **Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj College of Engineering, Shegaon**
- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest.
- E) **SW Systems, Pune** the Second Party is engaged in Business, Software, Skill Development, Education, R&D & Programming Services in the fields of premier destination for latest and future technology training in the engineering fields.
- F) **SW Systems, Pune**, the Second Party is promoted by 1, Amit Complex, Tilak Road, Opposite New English School, Pune 411030. Maharashtra, India.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and financial documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 **Curriculum Design:** Second Party will give valuable input to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 2.3 **Industrial Training & Visits:** Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into the latest developments / requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops / Industrial Sites for the

hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party as per decided financial terms suitable for both parties.

- 2.4 **Internships and Placement of Students:** The Second Party may actively engage to help the delivery of the Internship and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs, as per AICTE Internship Policy. The Second Party may also register itself on the AICTE Internship Policy Portal for disseminating the Internship opportunities available with them.
- 2.5 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of, ***Manufacturing and the Architecture, Engineering, and Construction (AEC) industry in Educational Training Systems.***
- 2.6 **Skill Development Programs:** The Second Party shall provide training to the students of the First Party on emerging technologies, aiming to bridge the skill gap and enhance industry readiness. The financial terms and payment structure for these programs shall be mutually agreed upon by both Parties and formalized
- 2.7 **Guest Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements on mutual compensation agreement between both parties.
- 2.8 **Faculty Development Programs:** Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting industrial exposure/ training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 2.9 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
- 2.10 Consequent upon this MoU, there shall not arise any financial liability / commitment on the First Party i.e. Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj College of Engineering, Shegaon.

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

The knowhow of the joint projects executed under "NDA" (Non-Discloser Agreement) shall be joint IP or whatever decided as per the agreement at the beginning of project.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement shall remain in effect from **April 1, 2025, to March 31, 2026**, unless expressly terminated by either Party under mutually agreed terms. During this period, **SW Systems, Pune** (the Second Party) shall take effective steps for the implementation of this MoU. Any communication, correspondence, or action undertaken by the Training Partner or **SW Systems, Pune** (the Second Party) after the termination of this Agreement shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU.





- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

No information/drawings/design/or any material obtained by students during the training at **SW Systems, Pune** or by college, if done, both parties i.e. First Party and Second Party will mutually resolve.
