

As you are aware, All India Council for Technical Education has been mandated under the AICTE Act, 1987 to ensure maintenance of norms and standards with regard to technical education in the country. In exercise of this mandate, the Council insists on fulfillment of the minimum requirements prescribed for imparting technical education by the institution so that quality of courses is not compromised and stakeholders are satisfied. The Council also undertakes an annual inspection of the institutions and conveys deficiencies to them for rectification.

It has been observed however that notwithstanding the Council's repeated advice to comply with minimum norms and standards, many institutions continue to be complacent about taking steps to remedy the deficiencies.

Such institutions suffer from critical deficiencies of faculty in proper cadre ratio, qualification, experience and other requirements. Feed back of students with regard to quality of education imparted by such institutions has evoked grave concern. The Expert Committees, following holistic appraisal during inspections, have also pointed out severe shortcomings.

The institution has been found to be suffering from several deficiencies, which are listed in Annexure-A for your perusal. Shortage of faculty is of gravest concern.

The deficiencies in respect of faculty (including proper cadre ratio & qualification etc.) could have rendered your institution liable for punitive action including being placed in no admission/ reduced intake category. However the Council has decided to take a lenient view and give you yet another last opportunity to rectify the deficiencies particularly with regard to faculty shortage, proper cadre ratio & requisite qualification. 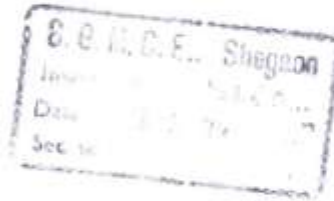

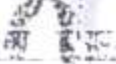



GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION OF NON-SPONSORED CATEGORY
STUDENTS TO FULL TIME PG COURSE(S)
(Ref: 10th meeting of EC of the AICTE held on 24.05.85)

Only GATE qualified candidates should be admitted to Full Time PG programmes for Non-sponsored category of students (General & SC/ST). When GATE qualified candidates are not available, admission may be given on merit to those who are not qualified in GATE.

For receiving PG Scholarship, a student must have qualified in GATE. However, a GATE qualified student does not automatically become eligible to receive a scholarship. Scholarship to a GATE qualified student will depend on availability of the same in an institution. Due to financial constraints, as a policy, AICTE does not approve any further scholarships to the Institutions. In fact, the AICTE has reduced the number of scholarships to 70% of the existing level in the AICTE funded institutions. When the number of scholarships is less than the number of GATE qualified students admitted, the distribution of scholarships shall be on merit in respective category (i.e. general & SC/ST) among the GATE qualified candidates.

**GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION OF SPONSORED
CANDIDATES TO FULL-TIME PG DEGREE PROGRAMMES**
(Ref: 8th Meeting of the EC of the AICTE held on 15.2.95).

The following guidelines are laid down for admission of sponsored candidates to full time PG degree programmes:

- (i) The candidates who possess Bachelor's degree in Engineering / Technology / Pharmacy / Architecture / Planning (or equivalent) from AICTE approved institutions with at least 55% marks will be eligible for admission.

The minimum percentage of marks may be waived for those who are teachers either in Engineering Colleges or Polytechnics joined before 28.2.1989, the date on which the circular was issued prescribing the AICTE pay scales and qualifications.

Preference should be given to those candidates who are GATE qualified. Sponsored candidates will not be eligible to receive scholarship, even if they are admitted based on GATE score.

- (ii) The candidates must have a minimum two years' of full-time work experience in a registered firm/company/ industry/ educational and research institutions/ any Government Departments or Government Autonomous Organisations in the relevant field in which admission is being sought.
- (iii) There will not be any age restriction. However, preference should be given to those who are below 45 years of age.
- (iv) The mode of selection shall be such that merit is the sole criterion. No capitation fee or donation will be charged for admission.
- (v) A letter from the employer must be furnished stating that the candidate is being sponsored to get admission. The employer should also indicate that the candidates will not be withdrawn midway till the completion of the course.
- (vi) The fee structure for the sponsored candidates should be as decided by the concerned institutions. The fee for the candidate should normally be borne by the sponsoring organisation wherever possible.

VI. AICTE APPROVAL

1. There shall be a separate Governing Council for the institution and it shall be constituted as per the guidelines prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
2. The infrastructural, instructional and other facilities including teaching staff, equipment etc. shall be provided as per AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.
3. A building with required space as per AICTE norms shall be provided separately for this programme.
4. A library shall be established with adequate number of titles, books, journals (both Indian & Foreign) etc.
5. A computer Centre with adequate number of terminals, printers etc. shall be established.
6. No new courses shall be introduced without approval of the AICTE. The teaching staff shall be in the pay scales as per the AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.
7. The admission shall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other facilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE/Govt. of India/State Govt. and that sanction of the University has been obtained.
8. The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the competent authority within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
9. The administrative, academic and other records including accounts shall be maintained for this programme. The accounts shall be audited annually by a Chartered Accountant and all the records and reports shall be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorized by it.
10. The objectives of the course, the procedure for evaluation/assessment of students shall be in accordance with the norms prescribed by the AICTE.

10. The management shall follow all conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time and a registered legal undertaking to this effect shall be submitted to the AICTE by July 1984.
11. The management of Rs 10 lacs shall be credited to the account of the society and the receipt shall be submitted to the AICTE by July 1984.
12. The institution by virtue of the approval given by AICTE shall not automatically be deemed eligible to any financial grant or subsidy from the Central or State Government.
13. The information furnished in respect of the proposal shall be factual and correct. In the event of any information found to be false, misleading or incomplete the approval accorded may be withdrawn by the AICTE.
14. The institution shall furnish regular returns and reports as desired by AICTE in order to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic standards. The progress report on the above conditions as on 31st December, and 31st May of each year shall be submitted by the institution to the AICTE during 1984-85.
15. This approval is further subject to compliance with the "SCHEDULE" as prescribed by the Supreme Court in its judgment in the case of *State of Madhya Pradesh vs. Union of India*, 1982 (1) SCC 607 of 1982 in 1982-83 of 1982-83 and others and the relation of the State and others to be issued by the AICTE, UOI on 15th March 1984.
16. In the event of non-compliance by the society with the guidelines, norms and conditions laid down by AICTE from time to time, the AICTE or a body or authority appointed by it, will be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval without co-operation of any related agency and shall not be liable for arising out of such a withdrawal which shall be the concern of the concerned society.

8. Nominee of the Affiliating Body, University/State Board of Technical Education.
9. Nominee of the State Government-Director of Technical Education (Ex-Officio).
10. An industrialist/technologist/educationist from the Region nominated by the State Government.
11. Principal/Director/Dean of the institution (as nominee of the Society/Trust, etc.) - Member-Secretary.

The number of members can be increased equally by adding nominees of the registered society and by adding an equal number of AICTE nominees who shall be industrialists/technologists/educationists from the region keeping in view the interest of the Technical Institution and are to be nominated by the Regional Committee. The total number of members of a Governing Body shall, however, not exceed 21.

The Chairman of the Governing Body should preferably be a technical person either an entrepreneur, or an industrialist or an educationist of repute who is interested in the development of technical education, is a member of the parent Society/Trust and has demonstrated an interest in promotion of quality education in general and, technical education in particular.



Sir,

I am to state that, on consideration of the report of the Expert Committee which assessed and reassessed the proposal on 2.2.1991 and 8.5.1992 respectively and the recommendations of the Standing Committee of the Western Regional Committee (WRC) made on 23.2.1991 and 20.5.1992 and the compliance reports submitted by the College vide their letters dated 6.5.1992 and 27.7.1992, the All India Council for Technical Education has accorded approval to the Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj College of Engineering at Shegaon, Maharashtra, established under the aegis of Shri Gajanan Shikshan Sanstha of Shegaon to conduct the following existing degree courses in Engineering with the annual intake shown against each during the academic sessions 1992-93 and 1993-94.

1. Electronics Engineering	120 (one hundred & twenty)
2. Computer Engineering	60 (sixty)
3. Electrical Power System Engineering	60 (sixty)

The above approval is subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions :

1. The Sanstha shall utilise the plot of land admeasuring about 25 ha and the building space of 15,600 sqm. already constructed as well as the additional 4,000 sqm. to be constructed exclusively for the College of Engineering.
2. The Sanstha shall incur expenditure on equipment to the tune of about Rs.30 lakhs per year during the next two years to make good the deficiencies in the various laboratories.

3. The Sanstha shall provide adequate infrastructural and instructional facilities to run all the Four Years of the Degree courses mentioned above.
4. The Sanstha shall provide a total of 96 faculty members (13 Professors, 26 Asstt. Professors and 57 Lecturers) for conducting the existing courses and the necessary recruitments for removing the deficiencies shall be completed by December, 1992.
5. The technical supporting staff shall be provided and necessary recruitment to remove the deficiencies shall be completed by December, 1992.
6. The necessary recurring and non-recurring expenditure shall be made by the Sanstha as per the AICTE norms.
7. The Management including the Governing Body of the College shall be constituted and the Chairman of the Body appointed as per the guidelines of the AICTE.
8. The teaching staff should be recruited on an All India basis by open selection and as per procedure, qualifications, experience etc. as prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. State-based selection would be permissible for such posts for which the State Govt. prescribes "State-Based Selection" as a general policy.
9. The admissions shall be made on merit and as per the guidelines issued by the AICTE from time to time.
10. The tuition and other fees shall be within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE. No capitation fee shall be charged from students/guardians of the students in any form for admission.
11. The AICTE scales of pay should be granted to the teaching faculty.
12. The accounts of the College shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant and be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorised by it.
13. The College shall not alter the approved intakes under any circumstances without the prior approval of the AICTE.
14. The College shall neither close any of the approved courses nor start any new course in the College without the prior approval of the AICTE.
15. The College and the Sanstha shall follow strictly any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.

The Sanstha shall submit general and specific undertakings duly registered on the non-judicial stamp paper to the AICTE for fulfilment of the above conditions by 15.11.1992.

An Expert Committee will visit the College by May/June 1994 to assess the progress made by the College and to make recommendations for extension of approval or otherwise thereon for consideration of the WRC and the AICTE.
