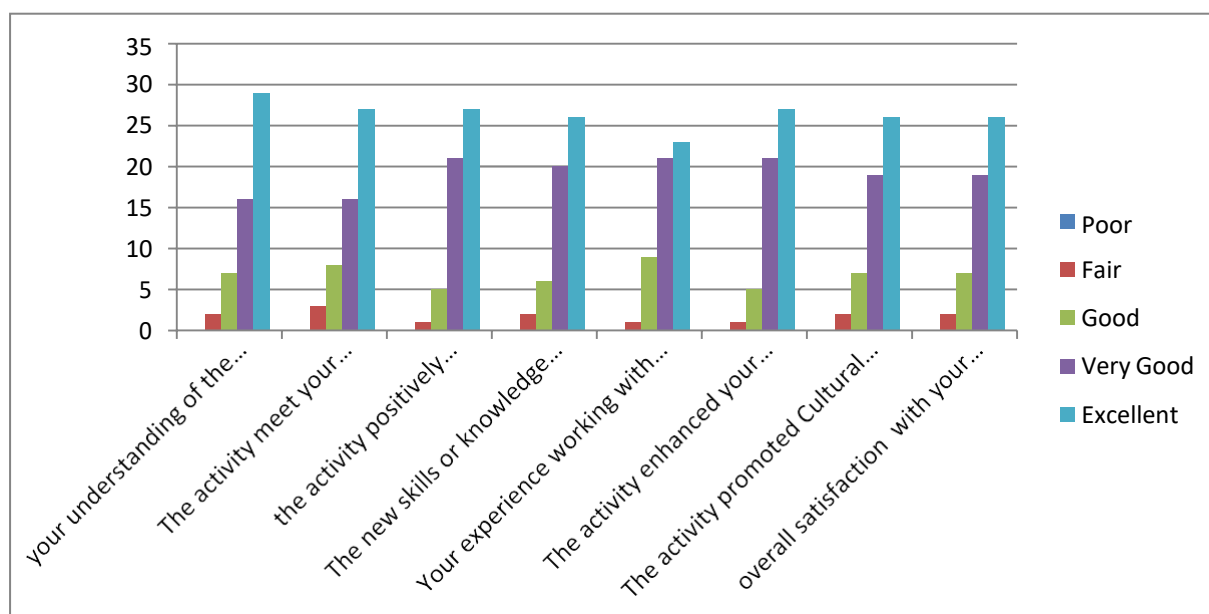

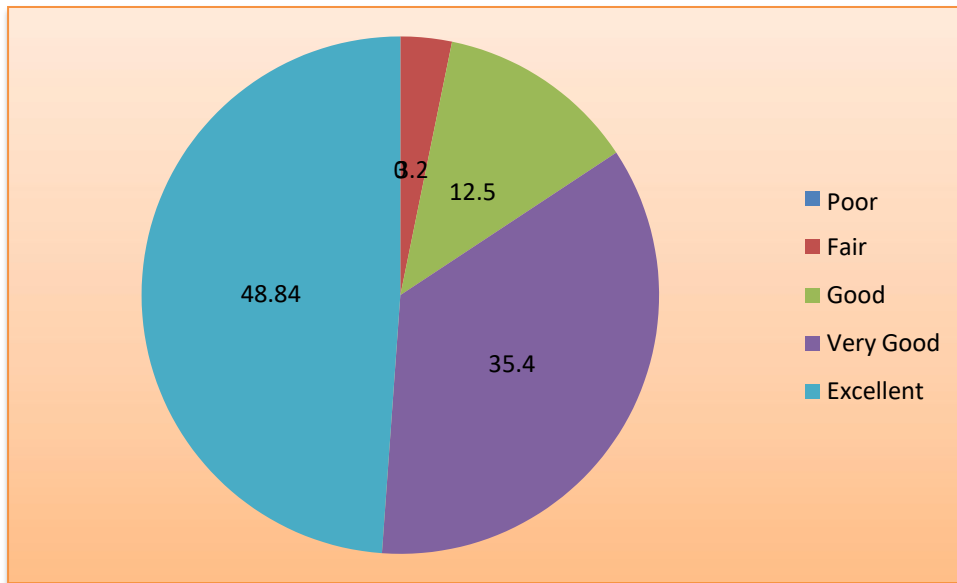

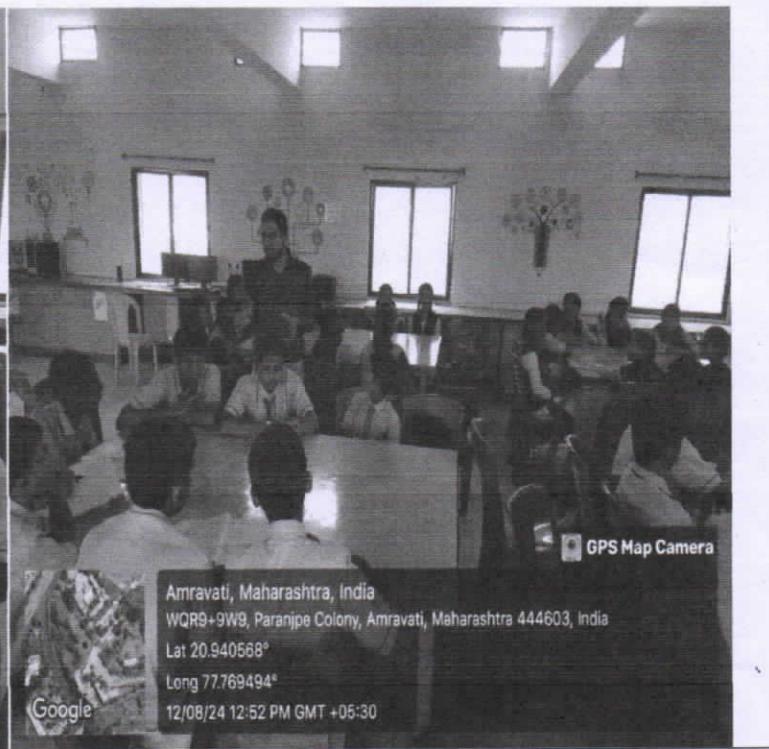
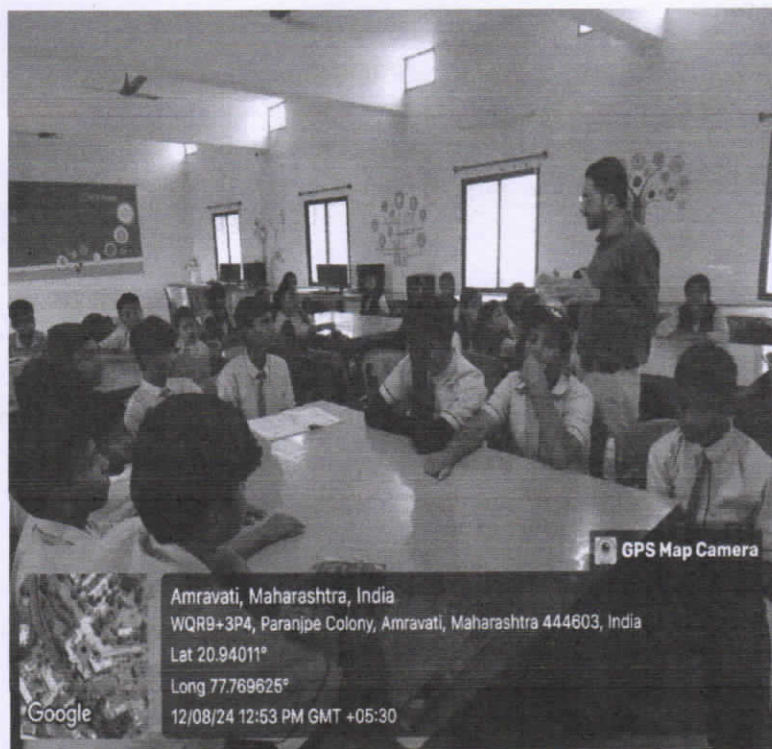
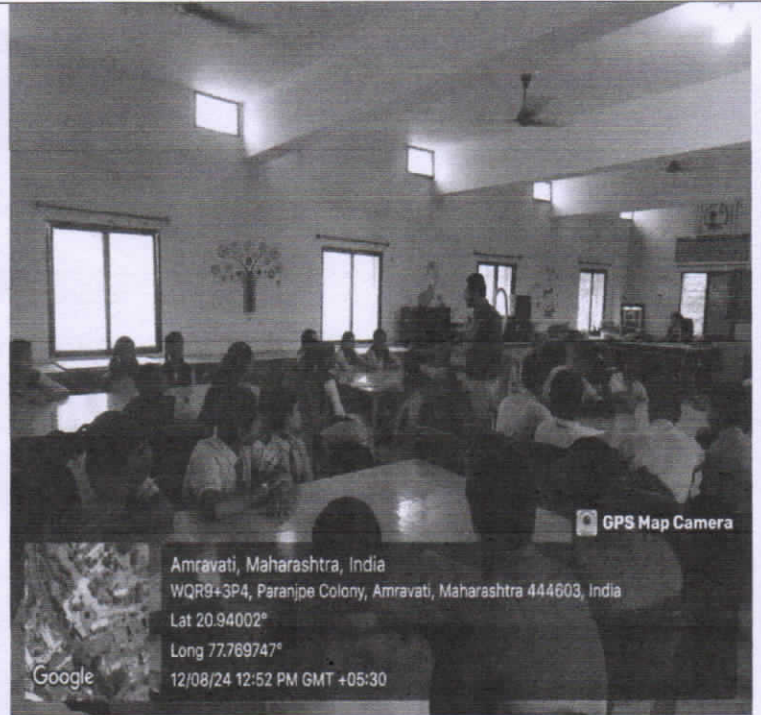
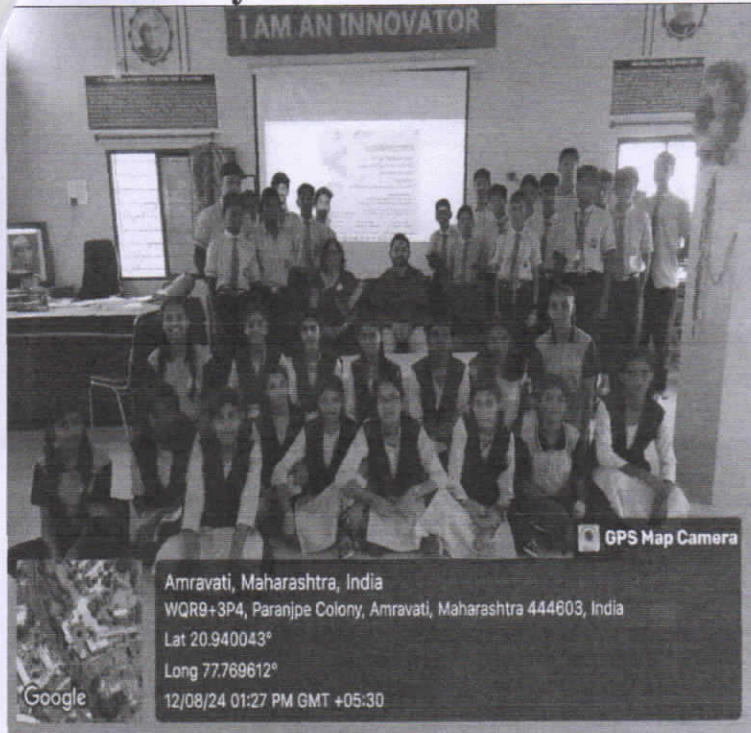
## Overview of the Program:

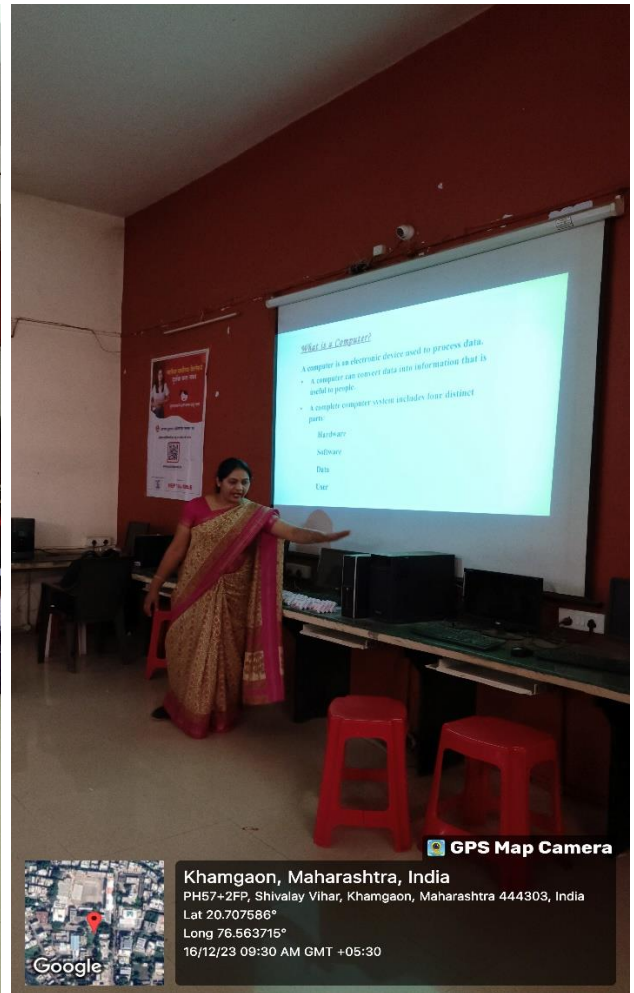

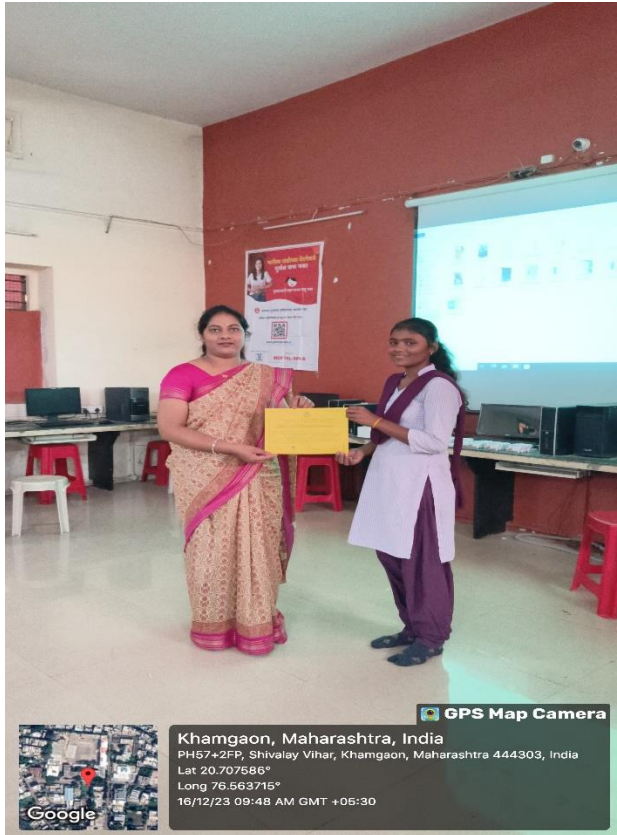


## Overview of the Program:
