Grand Alumni Meet 2024

SSGMCE, Shegaon, holds its Grand Alumni Meet annually, and the recent one was the eighth consecutive gathering on campus. In total, the institute has organized 24 alumni meets, showcasing the enduring tradition of connecting with and involving alumni in the development of the student community.







Preparation for an alumni meet at college is a significant undertaking that requires careful planning and execution. The following steps were taken in this connection:

- The date was fixed well in advance to give alumni plenty of time to plan and make arrangements to attend.
- The database of around thirteen thousand alumni has been created. All of them were invited through bulk SMS, e-mails, promotional posters on social media and calls for confirmation.
- The event's schedule and activities were planned which included a formal program with speeches and presentations, as well as informal activities such as tours of the campus, networking events, reciprocating speeches, alumni faculty student interaction (AFS), cultural event and social gatherings.
- The student and faulty teams (Registration, Travel and Accommodation, Catering, Press & Publicity, Technical, Discipline, Cultural etc.) were formed to secure necessary resources and facilities for the event. This included booking venues, arranging for catering, and securing equipment and audio-visual support. Arrangements for accommodation and transportation were made for the alumni who were coming from far off places.
- The event was promoted through email, social media, and mail, as well as through the college's website and other communication channels.
- Name tags, registration forms, program schedule, feedback form and other necessary materials for the alumni meet were provided in the kit.
- The alumni coordinators and its team managed and oversaw the event on the day of the alumni meet to ensure that everything runs smoothly.



By following these steps, the college ensured a successful and memorable alumni meet that would foster a sense of community and connection among alumni, as well as promote the college's achievements and goals.

Expert Talk on Core Telecom Journey and Career Options

The Expert Talk on Core Telecom Journey and Career Options, featuring Mr. Pankaj Nirale, unfolded as a captivating exploration of his professional journey. The session commenced with him providing an insightful overview, skillfully setting the stage for a discussion that delved into the wealth of knowledge derived from his life journey.

As he shared anecdotes from his college experiences, he underscored the crucial role of continuous technical learning in staying ahead of the times. The narrative transitioned to his early career, marked by a whirlwind of experiences across multiple companies within the first few years. He secured a stable position with an impressive 14-year tenure starting in his fourth year, laying a substantial foundation for the narrative that unfolded.Reflecting on the challenges of his initial days at Lucent .

The narrative then unfolded the chapters of his ascent from a support engineer in 2004 to the distinction of becoming the youngest customer success manager in 2009. By 2012, he found himself steering a global team comprising 52 engineers, underscoring not only his personal growth but also his ability to lead and inspire others. Various experiences, such as trying organic farming and founding a healthcare company, highlighted the significance of resilience in dealing with setbacks. Remarkably, he returned back to his professional roots, rejoining the company where he had spent 14 formative years.

The session concluded on an engaging note with telecom brain teasers, encouraging students to ponder thought-provoking questions about the industry. Before bidding farewell, he graciously shared his email for further inquiries, and the session ended with a heartfelt vote of thanks, resonating with a sense of gratitude and motivation.





Session 2: DBA&R (M.B.A.)

The session featured prominent alumni, Mr. Sushil Deshmukh, Mr. Ashutosh Deuskar, and Mr. Pankaj Nirale. The session commenced with a warm welcome by Dr. H. M. Jha, who greeted the alumni with bouquets as a token of respect. Setting the tone for the event, Mr. Nirale shared his personal journey, recounting the challenges he faced post-graduation, such as a lack of confidence and limited exposure to the outside world.

Mr. Deshmukh delved into the significance of English proficiency and provided practical solutions, encouraging students to actively participate by posing questions.

As the session unfolded, students expressed their aspirations to earn money, prompting Mr. Deuskar to inquire about their specific plans.



In response to student queries about industry expectations, self-assessment of strengths and weaknesses, and frequently asked interview questions.

The session concluded with a compelling call to action, urging students to embark on their journeys immediately, take calculated risks, and envision themselves succeeding in their dream companies.

Session 3: CSE / IT Department

The session included alumni Mr. Ashutosh Deuskar, Mr. Sushil Deshmukh, Mr. Pankaj Nirale, Dr. Pramod Chopde, and Mr. Samir Chitre. It began with the experts taking the stage, introducing themselves, and encouraging students to actively participate by posing questions. Mr. Deuskar, in particular, delved into the challenges he faced during the nascent stages of his company.

To infuse energy into the session, Mr. Deshmukh initiated an engaging activity. In response to student queries, one question focused on the duration of a recession. The response emphasized that, while recessions may pose challenges globally, India presents a favorable environment for the next 10 to 15 years, for individuals with the right skills and networking insight.

Another student sought advice on securing a job while targeting a specific skill as a fresher. The speakers emphasized the need for a continuous learning mindset, and exploring opportunities beyond major corporations.

The session concluded with a powerful message encouraging students to start their journeys, explore diverse opportunities as they navigate the dynamic world of startups.





Session 4:

Crafting the Future

To bridge the gap between education and industry, an interactive session titled "Crafting the Future" was delivered during the Alumni Meet- 2017 for the first time by an alumnus, Mr. Nitin Wankhede. It was so influential that it has continued till present. More than 30 alumni have taken the session since then every year during the Alumni Meet. The basic idea behind conducting this session is to provide students with an opportunity to learn about the journey of successful alumni and learn from their mistakes.

Mr. Ashustosh Deuskar sir began the session by introducing himself, his college life, and the struggles he faced in the initial days of his career. He shared how he started everything from scratch, and how, over time, he built an empire of 1300 people.

The microphone was then passed to Mr. Samir Chitre sir, the founder of ELV Design Solutions. He began by giving a brief introduction about his startup and then shared his memories in college and experiences gained while working in the company.

Dr. Pramod Chopde continued the session by introducing himself and his initial days of jobs in Pune. He shared how he completed many degrees and Ph.Ds due to his passion for learning new things and how he switched from one job to another before finally settling with JioFiber.

Mr. Sushil Deshmukh, then, took over the session. He shared how he struggled in his childhood to get a job to earn money. However, after a few years, he started his own business from scratch and expanded its branches to many countries across the globe.

All the alumni inspired the students with their struggling yet successful journeys in their careers. They advised students to ask as many questions as possible by developing a thinking approach: think loud, think differently.

The session concluded with a questionnaire session. Alumni discussed with each other, and because of this, the students gained more insights from their journeys and experiences. They all connected the idea that 'being an entrepreneur is a different feeling'. Students learnt a lot of things from this session.

The day before, he noticed that some students lacked confidence. He addressed the concerns of students from rural and less developed backgrounds, saying that their background does not affect their potential for success. He said that hard work and dedication are what truly matter.



He wanted to make a positive impact and planned to initiate a series of communications with students to provide ongoing guidance and support. He called upon fellow alumni to join hands in supporting and nurturing the aspirations of current students.

Introductory remark by Mrs. Surekha Patil

Surekha Patil, an alumna from the 1994-1998 batch, began her address by recounting her educational journey. She has a master's degree in Computer Systems, Networking, and Telecommunications from San Jose State University and is certified as a yoga instructor.

She identified a significant milestone when the discipline and cultural values instilled by the college played a pivotal role in her success in the Short Service Commission Examination conducted by the Indian Air Force. She traveled to the United States in 2002, where she completed her masters and worked for several years. 
