Students are pleased with the coverage of the syllabus in the courses, and they appreciate the teachers readiness to deliver the material.


Students expressed a desire for more use of student-centric teaching methods that provide opportunities for hands-on learning.

Students expect more efforts to be made to enhance their employability skills by providing workshops, seminars, or courses specifically focused on developing skills that are highly valued in the job market.




Students expect more efforts to be made to offer career guidance and counselling services, such as workshops on resume writing, interview skills, networking, and job search strategies.



## Q1: Percentage of Syllabus coverage in the Class


## **Q2:** Teachers preparedness for the course delivery in the classes




































## Q19: Percentage of Teachers using ICT Tools while teaching




## Q20:Overall quality of Teaching Learning process in the institution
