Dr. Mashelkar offered words of encouragement to the participants, stating, "Whether you are 8 or 80 years old, when you wake up in the morning, say aloud to yourself – 'The best is yet to come,' and start afresh." This motivational message aimed to inspire a positive outlook and a proactive approach to personal and professional endeavors.

The session garnered participation from all faculty members and supporting staff, contributing to a

collective engagement with the transformative ideas and experiences shared by Dr. R. A. Mashelkar.

4. Participants were motivated to adopt a positive outlook, regardless of age or circumstances, and to approach each day with the belief that the best is yet to come

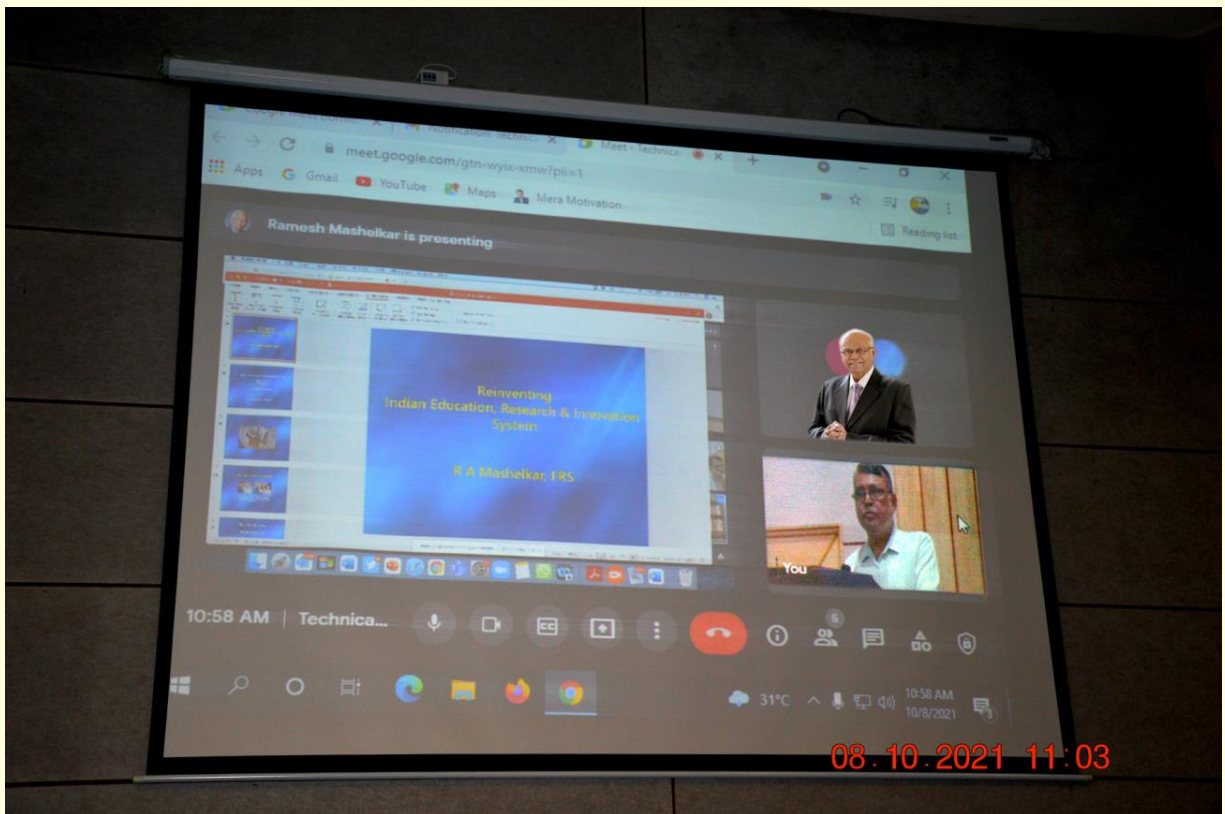

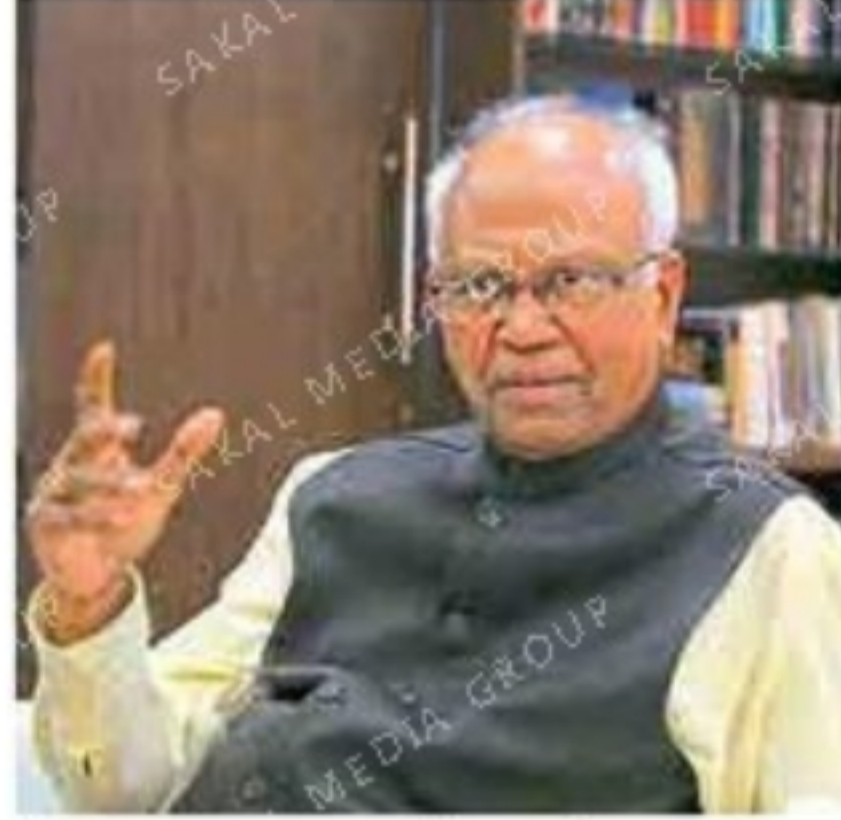

शकले. कालांतराने नारायणन राष्ट्रपती झाले आणि त्यांच्या हस्ते टाटा समूहाचे रतन टाटा व त्यांना पद्मभूषण सन्मान प्रदान करण्यात आला. त्यांनी हे उदाहरण सांगून शिक्षणाची शक्ती सिद्ध केली. विज्ञानाचा उपयोग मानव जातीच्या कल्याणासाठी व्हावा या महात्मा गांधींच्या विचारातून प्रेरणा घेऊन त्यांनी गांधीवादी अभियांत्रिकी आणि तंत्रज्ञानाची संकल्पना मांडली. "गांधीजी नेहमी म्हणत असत,

निसर्ग सर्वांच्या गरजा भागवण्यास समर्थ आहे, पण तो सर्वांची हाव भागवू शकणार नाही. गांधींजींच्या या विचारातून प्रेरणा घेऊन लोकांना भेडसावणाऱ्या समस्या आपण सोडवायला हव्या असं मला वाटलं," असं माशेलकर यांनी सांगितले.

दोन वर्षे सातत्यानं यावर चिंतन केल्यावर त्यांनी आणि सी. के. प्रल्हाद यांनी मिळून गांधीवादी अभियांत्रिकीवर एक प्रबंध सादर केला. हा प्रबंध हार्वर्ड बिझनेस रिव्ह्यूमध्ये २०१० साली प्रसिद्ध झाला. "कमीत कमी साधनसंपत्तीचा वापर करून जास्तीत जास्त लोकांचं कल्याण होईल, अशी उत्तम कामगिरी करणं," हे गांधीवादी अभियांत्रिकीचं सार आहे असं त्यांनी नमूद केले. या व्याख्यानासाठी महाविद्यालयाचे संचालक, प्राचार्य, प्राध्यापक आणि कर्मचारी मोठ्या संख्येने सहभागी झाले होते.


Project Completion Report

On 9th June we received a letter from AICTE, New Delhi to intimate grant of Rs.1, 74,300/- for organizing on site conference on Innovation management.
