a. **Governing Law.** This Agreement shall be governed by, and interpreted in accordance with, the laws of the Philippines and India.

b. **Venue of Suit.** Any legal action, suit, or proceeding arising out of, or relating to, this Agreement shall be brought or instituted in the appropriate courts of Batangas City, Shegaon City and the Parties hereby irrevocably submit themselves to the jurisdiction of such courts.

c. **Severability.** If any one of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall be held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect under any applicable law, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions contained herein shall not in any way be affected or impaired.

d. **Assignability.** This Agreement shall be binding upon and shall be to the Benefit of the Parties and their respective successors and permitted assigns, if any, but neither this Agreement nor any rights hereunder shall be assigned directly or indirectly by the SECOND PARTY without the prior written consent of the FIRST PARTY, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld.

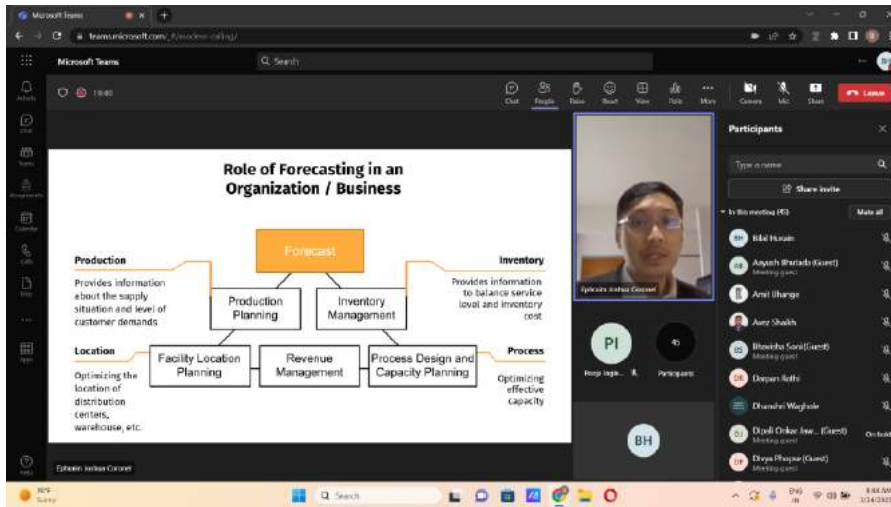

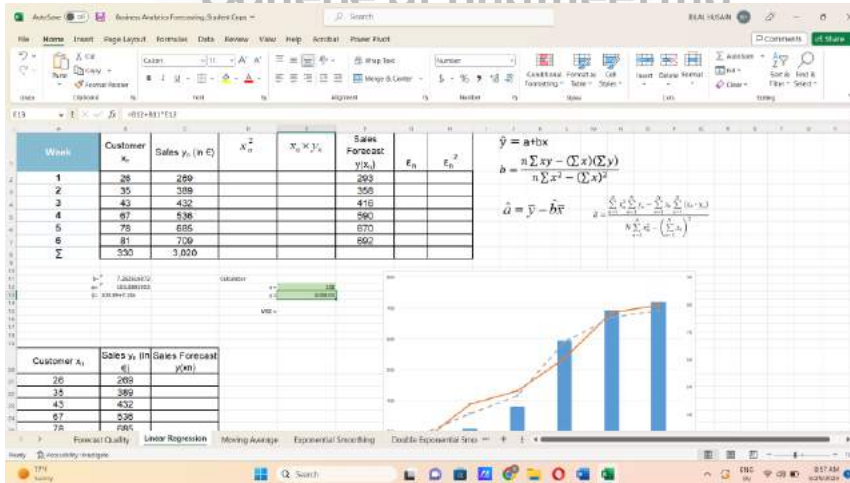

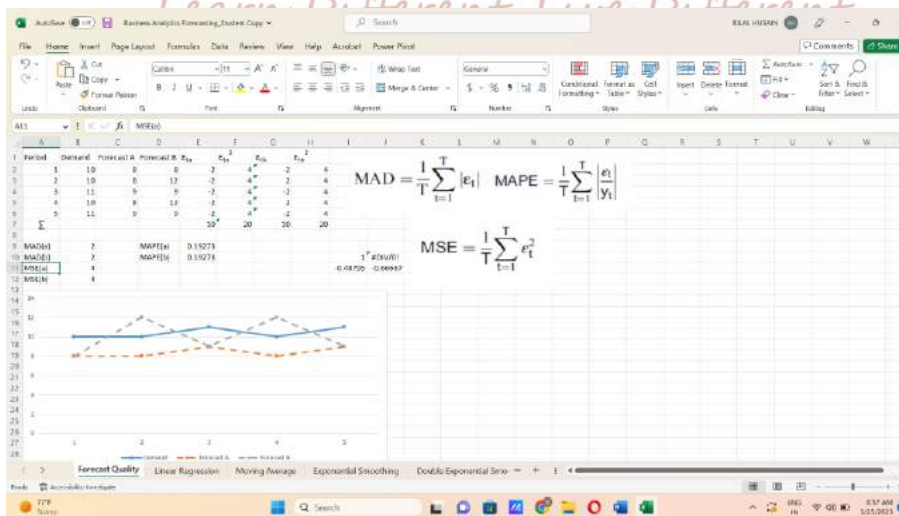

Report for Day 3 of Business Analytics Workshop

Date: 28 March 2023

Time: 8.30am – 10.30 am IST

The third day of the Business Analytics Workshop focused on different types of forecasting methods such as moving average, exponential smoothing, double exponential smoothing, and triple exponential smoothing. The primary objective was to compare the forecasting quality of each method using the mean squared error (MSE) in Excel.

The workshop started with a brief introduction to moving average forecasting, which is a simple forecasting technique that involves calculating the average of a set of values for a particular period. The MSE of the moving average method was calculated using Excel, and its quality was compared with other forecasting methods.

Next, the workshop focused on exponential smoothing, which is a time-series forecasting method that uses a weighted average of past values to forecast future values. The MSE of the exponential smoothing method was calculated, and the results were compared with the moving average method.

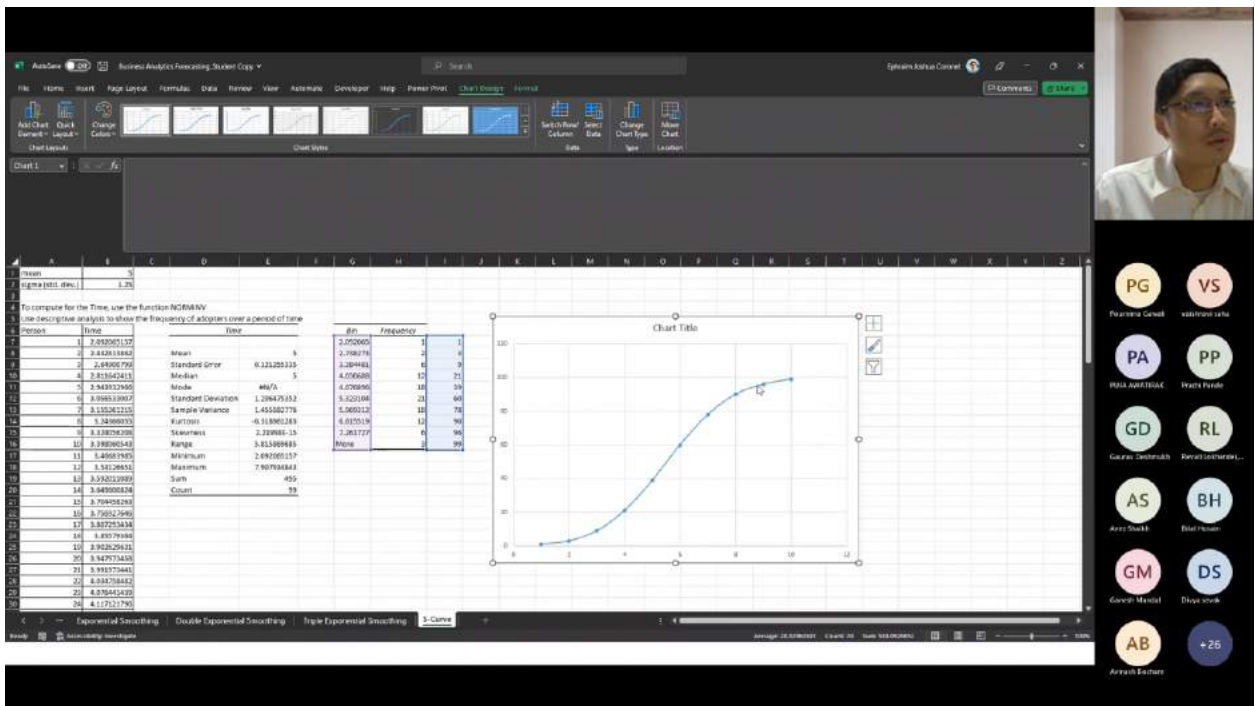

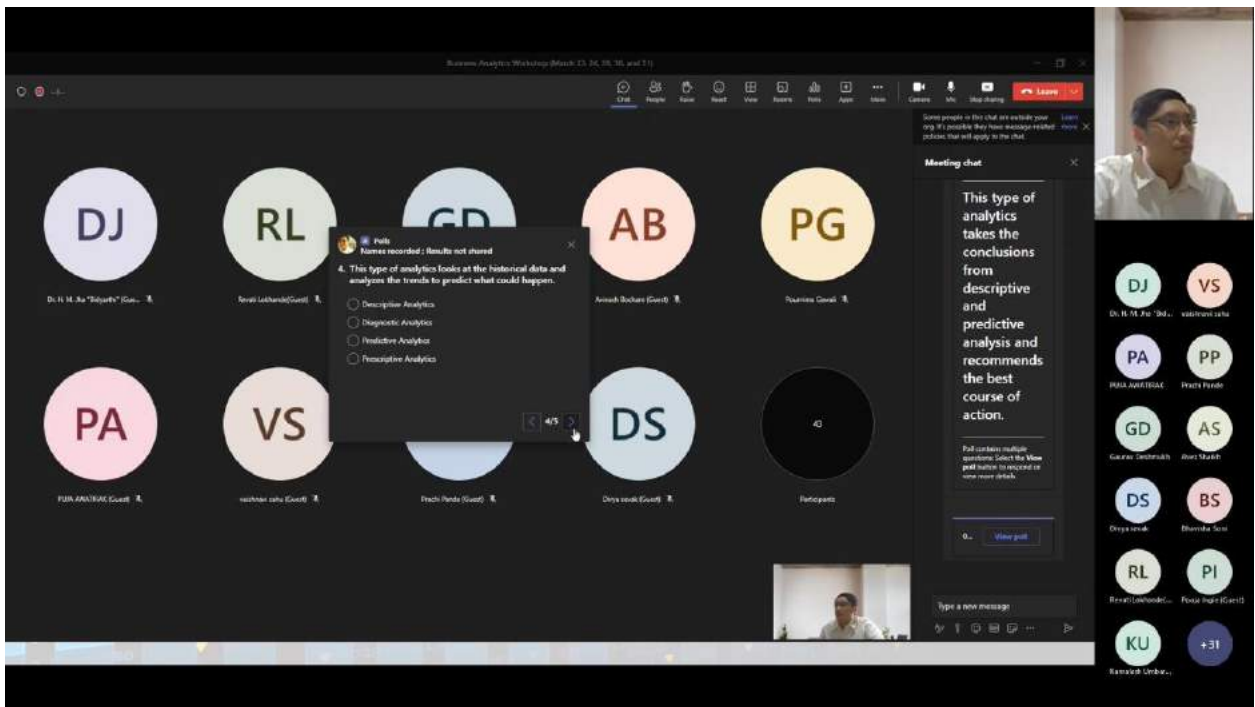

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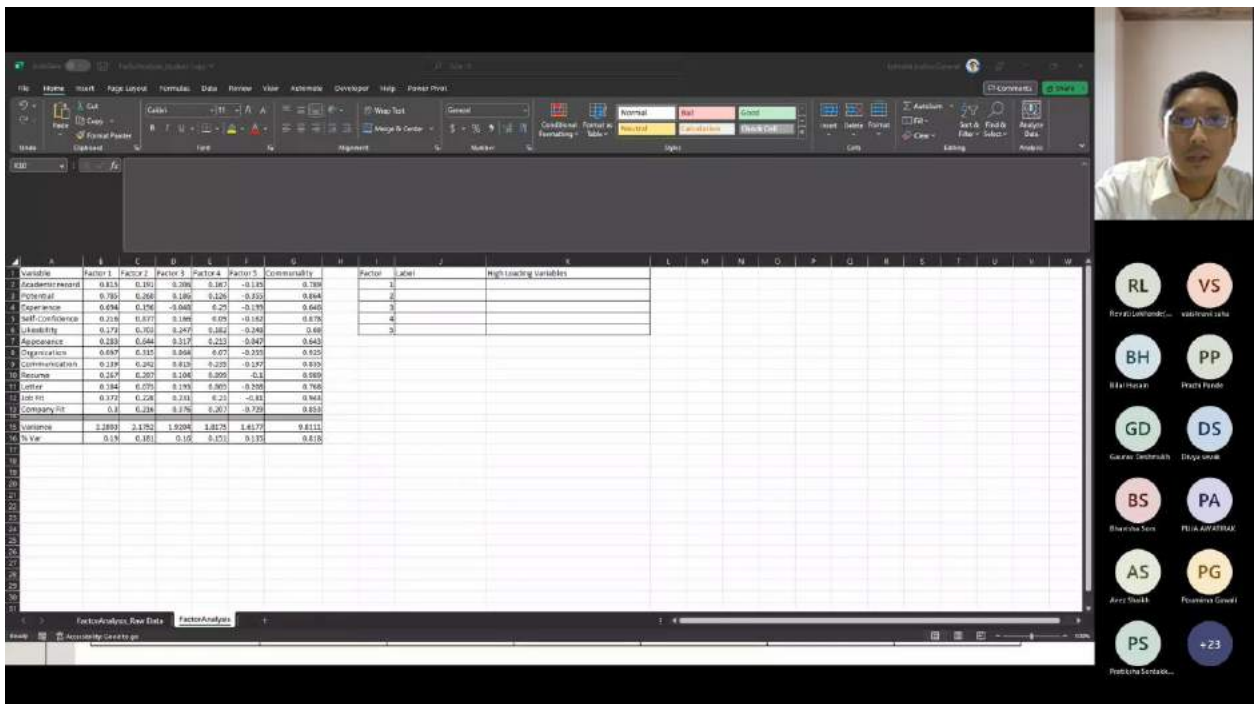

CASE STUDY

How a business used data to identify internal mobility as a key to retention.

One of Nielsen's businesses engaged its people analytics team to understand why the company was losing talent. Starting with five years of people data in a (big) spreadsheet and some hypotheses, they identified the factors most highly correlated with attrition.

The biggest finding was that **employees with a change in job responsibilities due to promotion or lateral movement within the past two years were much less likely to leave**. This insight prompted Nielsen's leadership to make it easier for employees to pursue jobs internally, and to identify at-risk high performers and proactively put opportunities in front of them.

3.2. SGIARC-TBI will not enter into direct business of the incubatee, and therefore will not be held accountable for any business-related obligations.
3.3. Nothing in this Agreement creates any kind of business obligation for either Party except that SGIARC-TBI will provide the agreed resources to the Incubatee.

4. LICENSE OF THE PREMISES

Incubatee shall be provided with cubicle space (**Premises**) within the SGIARC-TBI building (**License**). The facility is equipped with AC, chairs and network line, and a desktop. Detailed specifications can be provided by SGIARC-TBI.

4.1. Use and Return of Premise:

- 4.1.1. Incubatee shall occupy and use the Premises for its business & business development activities, with the written consent of SGIARC-TBI. Incubatee agrees that it shall observe and comply with all laws, orders, rules, and regulations of any authority relating to the Premises, and will not permit the same to be used for illegal purposes nor permit any nuisance to be created or maintained thereon. Incubatee shall, at the termination of this License, return the possession of the Premises to SGIARC-TBI in the same condition as when possession was taken, ordinary wear and tear excepted.

- 4.1.2. Incubatee shall not permit any objectionable noise or another kind of pollution to escape or be emitted from the Premises or do anything or permit anything to be done upon the Premises which might tend to create a nuisance or tend to disturb any tenant in the said building or the occupants of neighbouring properties.

- 4.1.3. SGIARC-TBI shall not be responsible for any physical data and office equipment of the start-up for any damage or unforeseen conditions.

4.2. Alterations:

Incubatee shall make no alterations in, or additions to, the Premises without first obtaining SGIARC-TBI's written consent, and all erections, additions, and improvements made in or upon the Premises, either by Incubatee or SGIARC-TBI, shall be SGIARC-TBI's sole property, and shall remain upon Premises at the termination of this License, without compensation to the Incubatee.

4.3. Assignment:

- 4.3.1. Incubatee shall not assign this License or any interest hereunder and shall not permit any assignment at law, shall not sublet the Premises or any part thereof, and shall not permit the use of the Premises by any party other than Incubatee's agents without first obtaining the written consent of the SGIARC-TBI.

- 4.3.2. SGIARC-TBI shall not be liable for any damage either to any person or property, sustained by or due to the building or any part thereof, or any appurtenances thereof becoming out of repair or due to the happenings or any accidents in the said building, or due to any act of neglect of

any tenant or occupant of said building, or of any other person. This provision shall apply especially (but not exclusively) to damage caused by water, steam, sewerage, or bursting or leaking of pipes and shall apply equally whether such damage is caused by the act or neglect of other tenants or of any other person. If any such damage shall be caused by the act or neglect of the Incubatee, SGIARC-TBI may at its option, repair such damage whether caused to the building or to tenants thereof and Incubatee shall thereupon reimburse SGIARC-TBI the total cost of such damage both to the building and to the tenants thereof.

4.3.3. Incubatee agrees that all property upon the Premises shall be at the risk of the Incubatee only and that SGIARC-TBI shall not be liable for any damage thereto or theft thereof. At or prior to the termination of this agreement the Incubatee shall remove any signs so painted, placed or erected, and shall restore the walls and other portions of the Premises to which any of the said signs were attached to their original condition, ordinary wear and tear excepted.

4.5. **Default:**

4.5.1. SGIARC-TBI reserves the right to terminate this agreement by a 3 (three) months' notice to the Incubatee whereupon this License shall end. Accordingly, the Incubatee will surrender possession of the Premises to SGIARC-TBI and remove all effects therefrom. However, SGIARC-TBI agrees that such a unilateral termination shall not be made before expiry of a period of 12 (twelve) months from the date of this agreement.

4.5.2. SGIARC-TBI may forthwith re-enter the Premises and repossess and remove all persons and effects therefrom without being guilty of trespass, forcible entry, detainer or other tort.

5. **Common Infrastructure**

SGIARC-TBI provides a common pool of hard and soft infrastructure to be shared by all incubatees. Certain resources can be provided on a per charge basis by SGIARC-TBI on request of Incubatee and subject to applicable rules and norms in this regard.

6. **Institute Infrastructure**

SGIARC-TBI will facilitate access to college infrastructure upon request of the Incubatee as per applicable norms in this regard. The facility will remain under the overall control of SGIARC-TBI and will be available to the Incubatee only for specific activities, as requested by the Incubatee.

7. **Services of Professional**

SGIARC-TBI may identify and associate professionals for accounting, IP, Legal and management expertise on a part-time basis. Incubatees can avail of their services on prescribed charges. Any direct services provided to the Incubatee would be paid for by the Incubatee to the service provider on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

8. **CONSIDERATION**

8.1.1. Allotment of rooms at SGIARC-TBI building will include the wi-fi, facility, electricity, AC, desktop, office chairs and cupboard etc.

10.2. It is free to enter into this Agreement and fulfil and perform its obligations contemplated by this Agreement;

10.3. It owns and has a clear and unencumbered Intellectual Property Rights;

The arbitration proceedings shall be in the English language.

14.1. **Severability:** If any provision of this Agreement is invalid or unenforceable as against any person, Party or under certain circumstances, the remainder thereof, and the applicability of such provision to other persons, Parties or circumstances shall not be affected thereby. Each provision of this Agreement shall, except as otherwise herein provided, be valid and enforced to the fullest extent permitted by the Applicable Law.

14.2. **Waiver:** The failure of either Party at any time to require performance by the other Party of any provision hereof shall in no way affect the right to require such performance at any time thereafter. Nor shall the waiver by either Party of a breach of any provision hereof be a waiver of any succeeding breach of such provision or be a waiver of the provision itself. No waiver shall be effective unless in writing signed by both the Parties hereto.



(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as ‘Parties’
and individually as ‘Party’)

WHEREAS:

1. First Party is an Education company: BASE Education, Jalgaon
2. First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and cooperation will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide them with enhanced opportunities.
3. The Parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within the area of Aptitude Skill Based Training.
4. Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

22. This agreement will be valid only at the intentions of the parties involved therein, this MOU could be dissolved or canceled by either party at any time by giving 30 days' notice and shall not have any legal bindings in nature. should either or all the parties to it opt to not act upon it, the MOU loses its validity.

CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

23. It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

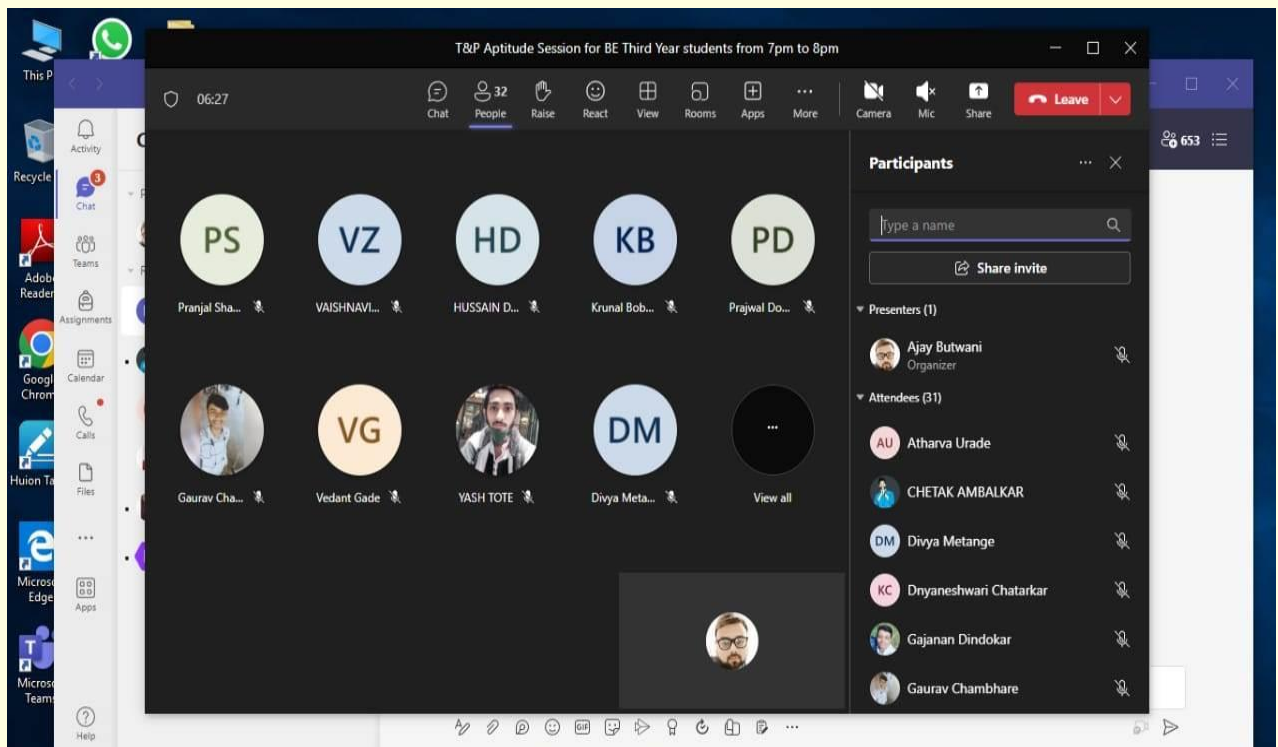
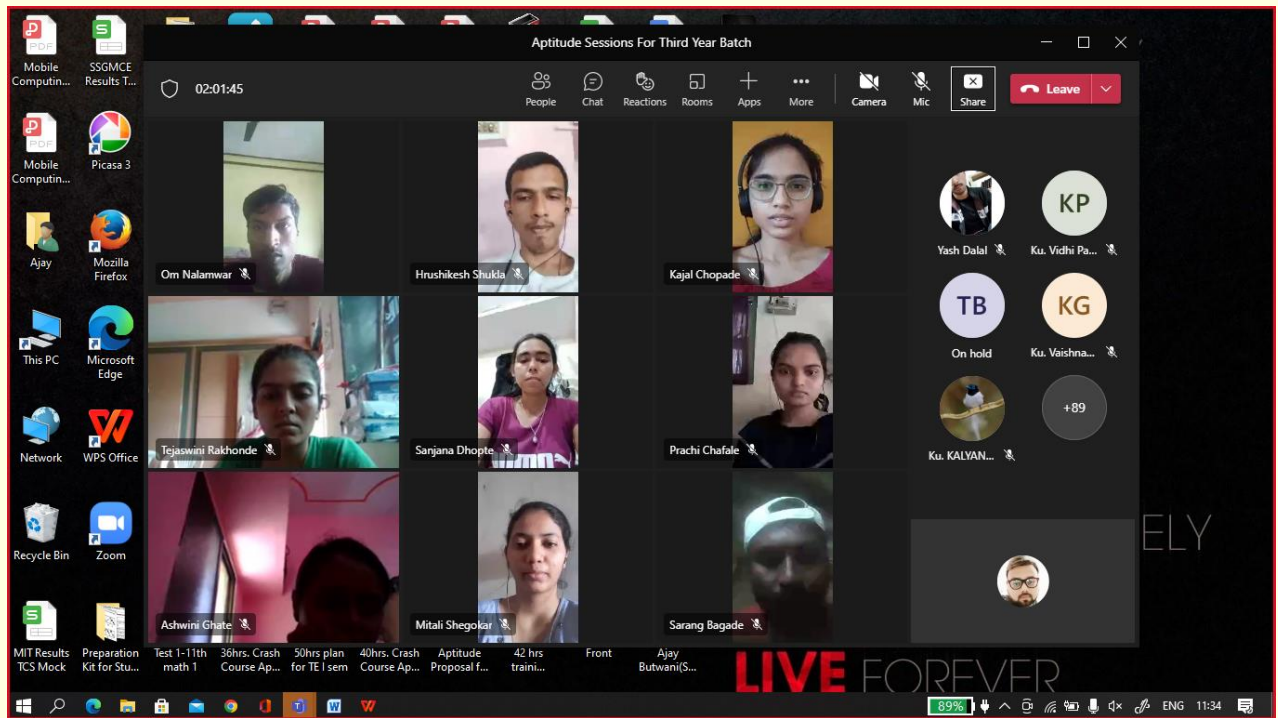

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as ‘Parties’ and individually as ‘Party’)

WHEREAS:

1. First Party is an Education company: S&K Associates, Nashik
2. First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and cooperation will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide them with enhanced opportunities.
3. The Parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within the area of Soft Skill Based Training.

The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds, and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding of the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties.
8. S&K Associates would be the training delivery partner for the second party on various trending Soft Skill trainings and the Assessment.
9. S&K Associates would be a training delivery partners for engineering students of Second party various trending Soft Skill trainings and the assessment for minimum of 11 months in one academic year (Usually Commence from July to May).
10. Soft Skill Training will be in in physical format as per need and availability of the trainers.

21. This agreement will be valid only at the intentions of the parties involved therein, this MOU could be dissolved or canceled by either party at any time by giving 30 days' notice and shall not have any legal bindings in nature. should either or all the parties to it opt to not act upon it, the MOU loses its validity.

CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

22. It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This **Memorandum of Understanding** (herein after called the 'MOU') is entered into on this the 27th day of December Month 2022 (Date 27-12-2022), by and between **ExcelR Solutions**, (Hereafter referred to as '**First Party**)

Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, pledge the other Party's credit, or extend credit on behalf of the other Party.
