More than 1000 rural people were contacted through Gram Panchayats and were made aware and informed about Savings and Investment through SEBI sponsored workshops. Dr. Hari Mohan Jha "Bidyarthi" generated consultancy of around Rs. 100000 through these workshops. Visiting faculty assignment at Saraswati College, guest talks at various forums and marketing assistance raised the total consultancy amount this year to approximately Rs. 300000.

A memorandum of understanding was signed between Saturday Club Global Trust, Akola Chapter and college initiating co operation regarding teaching- learning, mentoring, entrepreneurship support and research. Alumni overwhelmingly responded and promised about proactive initiatives during alumni meet.



Students pro- actively participated in entrepreneurship development programs, group discussions, debates, extempore, power point presentations, advertisement making, and community based projects, co curricular, extracurricular activities, sports for the sake of personality development. Parishkriti sponsorship was Rs. 20000 and students were encouraged with

cash prizes worth Rs 15000 by Syska Electricals, Khamgaon. Department wholeheartedly raised donation for the victims of floods at Kerala. Ten esteemed speakers from reputed industries and academia delivered guest talks this session.
