**Brahma Kumaris** is a spiritual organization predominantly led and managed by women, and presently has its headquarters in **Mount Abu, Rajasthan, India**. Interestingly, this mainly female-based organization was not founded by a woman but by a man, Lekhraj Khubchand Kriplani (1876-1969), also known as **Dada Lekhraj** of Hyderabad, in the 1930's. In the beginning, it was a gathering, headed by Dada Lekhraj, of a small number of devotees, which gradually grew larger, and eventually transformed into a worldwide organization with offices in 110 countries.

There are many organizations and personalities all over the world that are functioning to create and revisit happiness and harmony. Brahmakumaris is one of them. A study visit was organized to Brahmakumaris Center, Shegaon.


