In the beginning, it was a gathering, headed by Dada Lekhraj, of a small number of devotees, which gradually grew larger, and eventually transformed into a worldwide organization with offices in 110 countries.

There are many organizations and personalities all over the world that are functioning to create and revisit happiness and harmony. Brahmakumaris is one of them. A study visit was organized to Brahmakumaris Center, Shegaon.
