SSGMCE, Shegaon Features in DQ-CMR T-School Employability Index Survey 2022

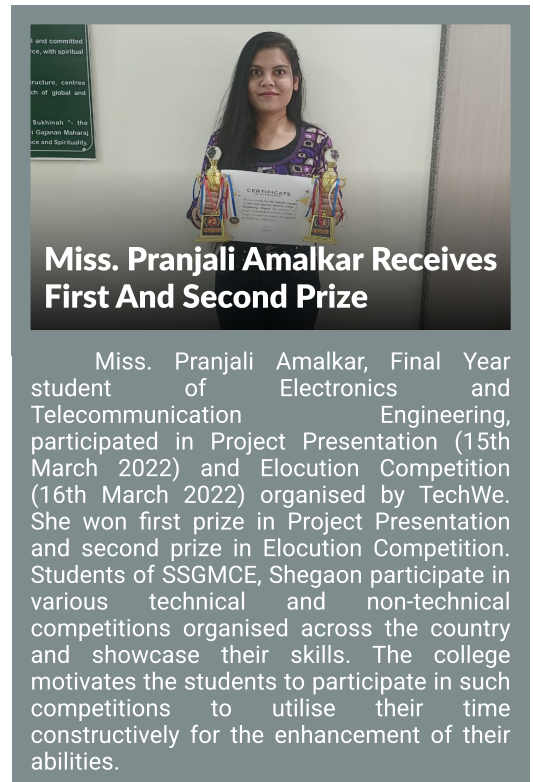

In a convocation ceremony organised by SGBAU, Amravati, Hon. Vice Chancellor Dr. Dileep Malkhede handed over these medals to him.





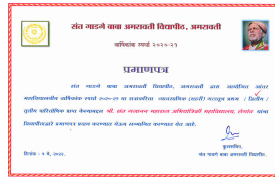
SSGMCE's Magazine "Tattwadarshi" wins Second Prize

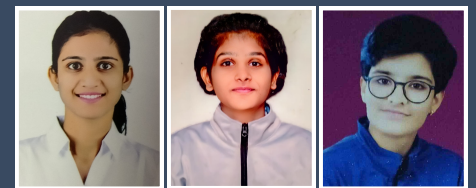


Five SSGMCE students to represent SGBAU, Amravati in Inter-University Sports Competitions

- Chinmay Harne, a first year Computer Science and Engineering student, has been selected in University Chess Team.

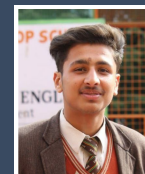

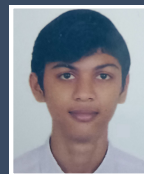
